**Goodwill Auto Auction takes the health of our staff and customers very seriously. If you are concerned about the risk for yourself or loved ones, please consider staying home. If you think you've been exposed to someone infected, or think you may be ill, please self-quarantine.**

COVID-19 continues to be a serious public health concern. In order to reduce risk, and to adhere to the recommendations of the CDC and the Ohio Department of Health, Goodwill Auto Auction will be making the following changes to our procedures at the auction for the foreseeable future:

- Only registered bidders will be allowed in the auction area and office. No additional family or friends; no observers.
- We will limit the number of people allowed in the office to register at any one time. We will have seating in the warehouse and let a few people in at a time. Registration is from 8am to 9am, and only takes a few minutes. We ask that you arrive as early as possible -don't wait until the last minute to register. Also, while waiting, we ask that you maintain a 6 ft distance in the public areas at all times.
- Between the time of registering and when the auction starts, you will have to wait outside the office. We recommend that you practice social distancing.
- Since your time in the office will be drastically limited, we recommend you dress appropriately for the cold weather that's expected Saturday morning.
- During the auction, we strongly request that you limit your time in the auction area by entering to bid only on the vehicles you're interested in. All other times, practice social distancing outside of the auction area.
- If you win a bid, paperwork will be done as usual; however, you will have to wait outside until your number is called. Again, please practice social distancing while you are waiting and when seated in the office. We will have seating arranged accordingly.
