To reduce risk of exposure and spread of disease, we will be making the following changes to our procedures for the foreseeable future:

- One person per bid ticket will be allowed in the auction area and office. No additional family or friends; no observers.
- We have opened registration to include Friday between 9am and 4pm, as well as Saturday before the auction begins.
- We will limit the number of people allowed in the office to register at any one time. We ask that you arrive as early as possible -don't wait until the last minute to register. While waiting, maintain a 6 ft distance in the public areas at all times.
- After registration, you will have to wait outside the office until the auction begins.
- Since your time in the office will be drastically limited, we recommend you dress appropriately for the weather. We are not currently auctioning any cars indoors – the entire auction is outside in the lot.
- If you win a bid, paperwork will be done as usual; however, you will have to wait outside the office until your number is called.
- Employees and customers are required to wear masks. Plexiglass guards have been installed, and a hand sanitizer station is available for all.

If you are concerned about the risk for yourself or loved ones, please consider staying home. If you think you've been exposed to someone infected, or think you may be ill, please self-quarantine. Employees and customers are required to wear masks.
